5. Golf genius Report.

Handicap System and Skins Game Adjustments.

- Handicap break for skins previously set at 13/12 (high/low) for both Palm Valley and Highland Falls.

- Participation in low skins higher at Highland Falls due to lower course rating and stroke loss.

- Proposal: Keep Palm Valley break at 12 and below (low), 13 and above (high); change Highland Falls to 11 and below (low), 12 and above (high).

- Goal: Balance skin payout pools between courses for equity.

6. Course Maintenance Report.

- Golf course maintenance updates: tee leveling, lake liner projects, weed prevention, and course conditions underway.

- Golf Committee approved tee leveling on all three golf courses; Eagle Crest sod installation completes Monday; Highland Falls halfway done, sod next week; Palm Valley next.

- Lake liner replacements approved: #17 at Highland (install July), #14 at Palm Valley (after overseas start); planning two more (including #13 at Palm).

- Weed prevention improved; bare areas present but no weeds observed.

- 90-degree cart rule emphasized; signage and rope added; Rangers instructed to enforce.

Action items:

- Maintenance team to improve communication, consider rope color changes, and review green mowing practices.

7. Member Q&A:

Course Operations, Greens, and Cleanliness.

- Request to use yellow ropes for better visibility; green ropes blend with grass.

- Suggestion to coordinate with pro shops on tee and flag placements for tournaments; concern over tees/flags being too far back for some players.

- Issue raised about cigarette butts around greens; request for better cleanup and smoker etiquette.

- Desire for consistent green speeds between practice and course greens; current speeds estimated as 7.5–9 on stimp meter.

- Suggestions to vary flag rotation more frequently and mow/roll practice greens first, before the golf course, for speed consistency.
